

Bradford Rose

"Never enough roses in my gardens..."

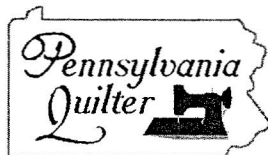
Quilt Size: 80" square • **Block Size:** 32 1/2" square

MATERIALS

The background fabrics and border are composed of 3 subtle ivory and pink prints. Two are dominant in the blocks. The scraps from these, plus a third print create the border.

- 2 1/2 yards print #1, for 2 blocks and borders
- 2 1/2 yards print #2, for 2 blocks and borders
- 2 1/2 yards print #3 for borders
- Red fabrics are dominant.
1/3 yard of 8 different reds, same color value.
You will need 1 3/4 yards for the border area alone.
- Assorted fat quarters or 1/4 yard of different dark green, green, light green, light red, and pink. Several prints from each color work well! Check scraps before buying!
- 86" square batting and backing fabric
- 3/4 yard red print, for the binding
- Freezer paper
- Matching appliqué threads
- 36" square clear vinyl (optional)
- Masking tape
- Fine tip marker

NOTE: If you choose to make half-square triangles using commercial paper foundation materials, you will need to make 232: 2 1/2" finished half-square triangles. This will require 116 foundation squares.
